#### Tart Cherry Harvest Moving Along

**PA-** Harvest in Pennsylvania is nearly complete. The crop picked longer than expected by nearly 20% (so far).

**NW MI-** A very few growers have started harvest and quality seems to be good so far.

**SW MI-** Harvest is nearly 50% complete and quality seems to be improving as time moves on.

**WC MI-** Harvest is moving along in West Central Michigan, with high variability in yields from block to block. Processors report some very large cherries, especially from blocks that have a light crop load.
