**NW MI** - NW MI has not started harvest. However, there was a very significant hail storm that will impact the overall crop size. The northern Leelanau and Antrim County areas were hit quite severely. The Old Mission Peninsula and the Benzi areas seem to have escaped the hail. It is still too early to know how much production might have been lost and whether or not it will be diverted or abandoned. Growers who suffered damage should contact their crop insurance carrier or the FSA (NAP) right away to file claims under these programs.
