**NW MI** - Started harvest in week 3. Fruit quality is good notwithstanding the storm from last week. Still unable to quantify the impact of the storm or how growers will respond. Quality so far very good.

**WC MI** - Had a big week for tarts. Quality reported as very good. Growers generally picking to their estimates. Some strong winds at the end of the week. Wk 4 should be as big.

**SW MI** - Basically done with harvest.

**NY** - Just a small bit of production. Far too early to determine trend.

**OR** - Harvest continues. Quality still good through Wk. 3.

**WA** - Harvest continued. Temperatures cooler than normal.
