**Fruit Quality Great.** Reports from the various districts is that the quality of the cherries is excellent and is pitting very well.

**NW MI** - Cherries are looking very good and fruit size and quality are also good. Leelanau and Old Mission a bit lighter while eastern side (Antrim, etc.) has very good crops. **WC MI** - The cherries were of very good quality. There will some more tonnage reported in Wk 5. **SW MI** - The harvest has tapered off significantly. This is the largest crop since 2001. **NY** - Continues with harvest and will pick in Wk 5 and maybe into Wk 6. **OR** - Quality good; quantity good. Weather has been quite hot. **PA** - Done. **UT** - Fruit quality good. Picking to estimate if not slightly more. **WA** - Good quality so far. Also quite hot. **WI** - Very early in the harvest still. Quality quite good.
