**Harvest 2007:**

**PA** - They have finished receiving cherries.

**NW MI** - A strong week of production but down from last week. Quality is still quite good. Many of the growers are done, but some will continue harvesting in week 6. Balatons still being harvested.

**NY** - Production similar to week 4. Quality still good. They will harvest through week 6.

**UT** - Processors have finished for the year. Quality held up throughout. There will be some tonnage with diversions.

**WA** - Everyone has finished production. Quality held up, but quantity down quite a bit.

**WI** - Probably close to one-half done. Good quality as has been reported in other states. Fruit moving through plants nicely.
