Harvest 2008:

NW MI - Harvest is still going. Both a larger quantity of cherries and larger fruit size are contributing to the larger than anticipated harvest. We will see both Mont.s and other varieties in current week.

WC MI - Montmorency cherries are effectively completed. May see some additional production in Week 6.

SW MI, NY, PA, WA, WI - Harvest completed.

OR - Quality has been very good. Fruit a bit smaller this year than last. Expect a bit more in Week 6.

UT - Picking longer than projected. More harvest expected in Week 6. Quality is holding up quite well in UT. Utah will be restricted this season.
