WC MI - Production tapered off a bit from Week 4. Not finished with production just yet. Will be close to estimate.

NY - Cherries are still of very good quality. To finish in Wk 6.

OR - Harvest continues.

UT - Another good week of production. Still very hot in UT, but quality is holding. Diversions also being done.

WA - Harvest complete.

WI - 2nd week of strong harvest. Still seeing good quality.
