There was a restatement of production in NW MI last week. Handlers previously double reported about 3.1 million pounds of production. This is corrected in Week 6. Actual production in Week 6 was 5.3 million pounds. A bit more production will be reported in Week 7.

WI is done. Overall quality was good but size was small.

The West is moving along nicely. OR continues with harvest and will through at least Week 7. The fruit quality is excellent and is holding up very well.

UT is in the middle of a good harvest and will continue harvesting at least through Week 7 if not a bit longer. Quality is still good.

WA cherries are still coming off the tree. Quality there is reported as very nice and fruit size is good.
