NW MI - Moving towards the end of harvest for the area. We will see some additional deliveries in Week 8. The cherries continue to look good with quality holding up.

UT - Finished harvest in Week 7. The crop in UT was quite abundant at 138% of USDA estimate or 142% of CIAB estimate. The quality held up quite well throughout harvest.

WI - Continuing with harvest in Week 8. Quality still okay. Likely to reach estimate.

Harvest Complete - SW MI, WC MI, NY, OR, PA, UT, WA. Corrections, re-allocations & reassignments in WC MI, SW MI and NY which affected total production for districts. NY ended up at 161% of USDA estimate, but only 114% of CIAB estimate.
