Utah finished production in week 8. OR will finish week 9, but it will not be a substantial amount.

The total production report so far is considerably less than was estimated. This was driven by the short crops experienced through-out the Mid-West as a result of poor pollination.

All of the Western states had larger than expected crops. The West did not experience the same pollination issues as did the Mid-West and fruit size was good.

The CIAB meets in Grand Rapids, MI on September 15, 2011 to review the Optimum Supply Formula in light of the crop size and to make any appropriate adjustments to this year's OSF calculations.
