#### CONGRATULATIONS. HARVEST IS DONE!

This year's crop at 286.7 million pounds was a good sized crop for the industry and quite a nice recovery from 2012. The quality of the crop was reported by almost everyone as "top notch", "excellent" or "great".

The cherries pitted quite well throughout the season. However, yields might be a bit smaller than usual because the fruit size was not that large in most areas.

Overall the harvest was very close to estimate being over by only 4%. WC MI was the closest to estimate at +2.3%. NW MI was very close, as well, at -2.3%. OR had spectacular production and exceeded its estimate by 113.5%. SW MI, NY and WI all produced substantially over estimate. WA fell shy of estimate by -10.4%.
