WA High temperatures during harvest.

WI Harvesting. Doubtful that they will reach USDA Est.

General - Orchard diversions not terribly prevalent. Growers and handlers opting to deliver, it appears. Entries for "Diverted fruit" = activities YTD. They have not yet been confirmed or issued.
